

Friendship – Make a friendship chain

This lesson is focused around what makes a good friend.

LESSON 2

1. You will need:
 - a. Coloured strips
 - b. A pen or pencil (coloured if possible) for each student
 - c. Glue or sticky-tape
 - d. A list of possible qualities of a friend to get students started (see below)
2. Play the video and pause as needed for discussion.

After video discussion and activities:

- Brainstorm with students what the qualities of a good friend are.
 - Funny
 - Friendly
 - Plays nicely
 - Supportive
- The students form groups of 3-4 and write one quality of a good friend on a strip of paper.
- The paper is then curled around to form a ring.

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- Students keep writing good qualities of a friend on more strips of paper and link them together.
